## ACES Insurance Collaborative Meeting Minutes

## March 29th, 2019 at 2:45 PM

<u>Attendance</u> - Directors present: Lisa Jones, Ansonia Board of Ed.; Tom Danehy, ACES; Tim Howes, ACES; Pam Mangini, North Haven Board of Ed. Also present were Chuck Petruccione and Sonia Kaminsky, Brown and Brown; Rob Janes, Anthem; and Deborah Carson, ACES.

- 1. Executive Session: Presentation by Albert Saavedra from Aetna.
- 2. Minutes: Motion was made by Tim Howes, seconded by Lisa Jones to approve the minutes of the February 22, 2019 meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
- 3. Q & A on Monthly Reports and Renewals: Chuck Petruccione reviewed the claims through February 2019. The results were as follows:
  - a. ACES claims have been increasing as expected but are still 15% below budget. No stop loss hits. The projected renewal increase is 3.2% as of now.
  - b. Ansonia claims have also been increasing and it is about 5% over budget. There have been stop loss reimbursements totaling about \$170,000 over the last 5 months. The projected renewal increase is 11.9% as of now.
  - c. North Haven BOE remains at about 15% under budget. There have been stop loss reimbursements totaling about \$300,000 over the last 5 months. The projected renewal increase is 2.8% as of now.
  - d. Town of North Haven is about 9% under budget. No stop loss hits. The projected renewal increase is 8.3% as of now.
- 4. Discussion of Sharing Risk: Petruccione distributed a document entitled "Pros & Cons of Combining Claims Experience for ACES Collaborative." Overall it was felt that the cons outweighed the pros, primarily due to the loss of individual ASL protection.
- 5. Invitation to East Haven: Petruccione stated that he is working with East Haven on the cost/benefit of joining. He and Sonia Kaminsky, as well as Deborah Carson will attend their BOE meeting on Tuesday, April 9<sup>th</sup>.
- 6. Prospective Members: Kaminsky has been in talks with West Haven. Jones asked about Waterbury. Howes stated that he had called them and they needed more time.
- 7. Audit: Howes put out an RFP for a separate audit of the Collaborative.

- 8. Wellness Budget: Carson discussed the need for ACES to have a wellness budget to implement some of the ideas formed with the Wellness Committee. The goal would be to have a Collaborative Wellness Program in 2020, but to build it from what is working for the individual districts in the 19-20 plan year. Janes suggested working with Anthem on this as well.
- 9. Meeting Schedule: Next meeting date is Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 AM.
