ACES Insurance Collaborative Meeting Minutes

June 14th, 2019 at 10:00 AM

<u>Attendance</u> - Directors present: Lisa Jones, Ansonia Board of Ed.; Tom Danehy, ACES; Ed Drapp on behalf of Tim Howes, ACES; Ed Swinkoski, Town of North Haven; Lynn Boisvert, East Haven Board of Ed. (via telephone). Also present were Chuck Petruccione and Sonia Kaminsky, Brown and Brown; and Deborah Carson, ACES.

- 1. Minutes: Motion was made by Lisa Jones, seconded by Ed Drapp to approve the minutes of the April 26, 2019 meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
- 2. Q & A on Monthly Reports: Chuck Petruccione reviewed the claims through April 2019. The results were as follows:
 - a. ACES claims have been increasing as expected but are still about 9% below budget with \$146,000 in stop loss reimbursements.
 - b. Ansonia is about 9.5% over budget. Stop loss reimbursements have been consistent since October 2018.
 - c. North Haven BOE is at about 10% under budget. Claims have greatly increased, along with stop loss reimbursements.
 - d. Town of North Haven remains at about 9% under budget. No stop loss hits.
- 3. East Haven Board of Education to enter into the ACES Insurance Collaborative effective July 1 Terms and Discussion: Chuck Petruccione and Sonia Kaminsky explained that Brown & Brown had negotiated with Anthem to reduce their administrative fees by \$5 PEPM, to put a hard cap on the discount share fee, and to reduce the overall stop loss fees such that East Haven's buy-in costs would be reduced significantly. Additionally, ACES administrative fee will be reduced for all members to \$6 PEPM.
- 4. Life Insurance Collaboration Update: Kaminsky stated that they were looking to get a 4 to 5 year guarantee for a renewal effective 12/1/19, with a more robust plan due to our larger purchasing power.
- 5. Terminal Liability Option added to Plan: Petruccione presented the recently negotiated improvements to ACES Collaborative's stop loss contract with Anthem, which will provide better long-term coverage.
- 6. Prospective Members: Since Brown & Brown recently added Wolcott Town and Board of Ed. as a client, they may make a good fit for the next plan year.

- 7. Marketing Plan: ACES Marketing Department recently met with Collaborative members to discuss a 2 year strategic marketing plan. A follow up meeting will take place next week to review the plan.
- 8. Meeting Schedule: Meetings will take place on the fourth Monday of each month at 9:30 beginning in July 2019. Meetings will be via conference call in July and August. Due to holidays, meetings will be help on the third Monday in December and May.
- 9. Adjournment: Meeting was adjourned at 11:20 AM.
