ACES can assist districts with compliance to HB 16-189, an Act Concerning Student Data Privacy. The law is multi-faceted with time consuming requirements. ACES follows data privacy best practices in the following areas:

- Inventory of existing applications using student personally identifiable information (PII)
- Establish an application review process that includes privacy, curriculum, and technology vetting
- Create an external website resource for parents
- Establish a breach notification process
- Contract tracking
- Awareness workshops for staff, students, and parents
