

ACES is hosting a Play-Based Learning Curriculum Consortium for the 2024-25 school year. New legislation guidance effective July 2024 mandates that school districts incorporate play-based learning for pre-kindergarten and kindergarten age students during the instructional day. Participants of the consortium will work collaboratively to create standards-aligned, play-based learning scenarios that can be integrated into their existing curriculum. During this time, participants will receive the necessary professional learning so that they can create developmentally appropriate, purposeful learning activities, and supporting materials.
